FREE DATABASE: GLASSDOOR

Glassdoor is a **FREE career resource** for your library that's helping job seekers and students get an inside look at over 26,000 companies – including company salaries, reviews, and interview questions posted anonymously by employees and job seekers.

Many features (such as salary data) are usually available only to those people who post their own information, but through Glassdoor's Library Partnership Program this data is freely available to anyone who accesses glassdoor.com through your library's web site. To register for the Library Partnership Program, send the URL of the page where you place your glassdoor.com link to me at databases@tenn-share.org. I will send the URLs to Glassdoor where they will authenticate your users based on your referring URL.
