FREE DATABASE: COMMON CHEMISTRY

A partnership between CAS (Chemical Abstracts Service) and Wikipedia, *Common Chemistry* provides a lookup of the **800 most common chemicals** by name or CAS Registry Number. The site itself provides common names, the chemical name, Registry Numbers, molecular formula, and chemical formula and structure. Links are provided to Wikipedia entries on the chemicals, which are produced in collaboration with CAS.
