FREE DATABASE: DISCOVERING AMERICAN WOMEN'S HISTORY ONLINE

March is Women's History Month, and the perfect time for ACRL Women's Studies Section to announce the winner of the 2009 Award for Significant Achievement in Women's Studies Librarianship, Ken Middleton. Ken is one of our own, a UTK graduate and User Services Librarian at MTSU since 1993. The award was presented to him in part because of his work on a free database, *Discovering American Women's History Online*. The database provides access to primary source materials, such as diaries, letters, images, etc., findable by subject, place, time period, and type.
