JSTOR is offering us a 9% discount off the Archive Capital Fee for new subscriptions to collections that have at least 10 TN subscribers. Previous subscriptions count toward this 10, so below I've listed the

collections that already have met the number. Any subscriptions to these collections will automatically get the 9%, as long as you can sign the single license (TBR/UT, this is in process).
