Sue Maszaros has worked with AutoGraphics to set up a search within TEL (<http://tntel.tnsos.org/>) that searches the Volunteer Voices database, several CONTENTdm databases, and the TN Encyclopedia of History & Culture. Click on TN Primary History Collections heading in **Advanced Search**. Although not perfect, the fact that it searches across all of these resources is a big plus. The idea is to create an entry page that will just search these primary source digital collections (with TN content) and the TN encyclopedia. Austin Peay, Fisk, Rhodes, Vanderbilt, other UT collections, and other sites will also be added. In effect, this would be the new entry page for Volunteer Voices.

The Agent Search could potentially cover more than 20,000 records (a number that would continue to grow):
