Average Savings Per Library

STAT!Ref Medical eBooks:

- **\$6,250** x 18 libraries = **\$112,500**

STAT!Ref Nursing eBooks:

- **\$911** x 28 libraries = **\$25,508**

STAT!Ref Anatomy TV:

- **\$1,578** x 15 libraries = **\$23,670**
